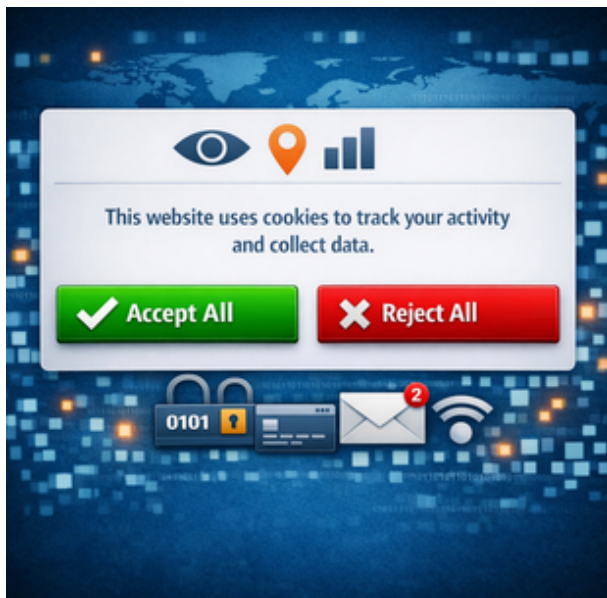


DPO highlights responsible data handling at BigCradle's Fellowship
