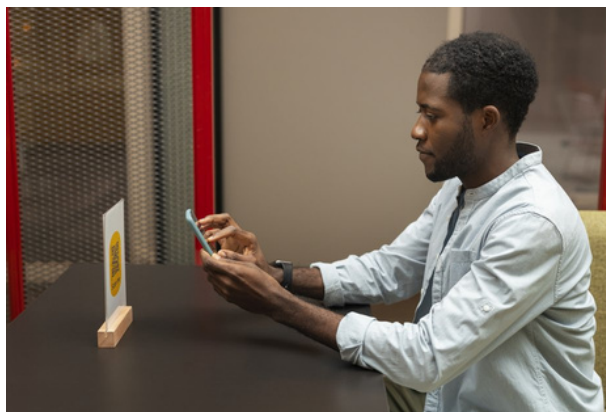
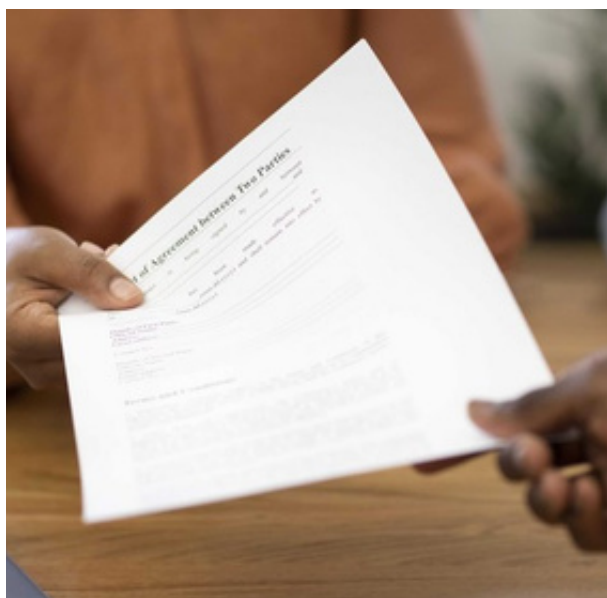


Safeguarding your data isn't paranoia, it's basic hygiene
