The National Cyber Security Authority participated in the Rwanda Internet Governance Forum and discussed the Data Protection & Privacy Law, emphasizing its role in safeguarding personal Data.

It was mentioned that the law ensures Rwanda aligns with global data protection standards for a thriving digital economy, adding that the regulator role is to balance compliance with enforcement.

The Data Protection and Privacy Office kickstarted a series of consultation workshops on developing sector-specific guidelines for implementing Rwanda's Law on the Protection of Personal Data & Privacy.

The sessions engaged key stakeholders from the sectors of health, media and education in reviewing, validating, and contributing to the creation of tailored Data Protection and Privacy Guides.

This collaborative platform allowed participants to discuss the unique data protection challenges within their specific sectors, ensuring the guidelines are practical, relevant, and aligned with the sectors' operational realities.

The initiative aims to strengthen compliance and promote responsible handling of personal data across different sectors.
